(1)International Equality

- Equality among industrialized nations
 - ⇒It's important to establish the effective post-Kyoto framework, in which equality among industrialized nations is maintained and which will lead in the global reduction of CO2 Emissions.
 - ⇒Indices which properly reflect past efforts (Equal marginal abatement costs)
- Equality among nations including emerging countries

(2) Japanese Green New Deal

Key element: Energy Supply

[Nuclear power generation]

- ⇒Nuclear power generation supply clean energy which emits less CO2. It is necessary for Japan to continuously promote nuclear power generation while securing safety.
- ⇒Japan needs to contribute to the world providing the technology of safe nuclear power generation.
- <Problems which need to be addressed>
- ◆to boost the capacity utilization ratios of nuclear power plant
- ◆ Japanese mentality
 - * History of Hiroshima and Nagasaki
 - * Radioactive waste disposal * lack of human resources
