- U.S. and China currently in competition on three tracks
 - Trade
 - Technology
 - Indo-Pacific security



Trade

 - Forced technology transfer and cyber theft; IP rights;
 Services; Currency; Agriculture; Non-tariff barriers
- Prospects for a Trump-Xi deal in March
- Domestic pressures
