### ■Jeffrey STEINBERG 氏

B.A. Political Science, Rutgers University, New Jersey, USA 1969 M.A. Social Science, Montclair State University, New Jersey, USA, 1972 Career:

Chief Editor, Executive Intelligence Review, 1975-present. Directs an international intelligence staff of over 50 fulltime analysts, covering political economy, national security, science and technology policy. Intelligence staff located in Washington, Wiesbaden, Paris, Milan, Stockholm, Berlin, Copenhagen, New Delhi, producing a weekly intelligence journal of 64-80 pages, along with special reports (currently released the New Economy, twice-weekly Alert Service, and special client studies.

### ■Helga Zepp LAROUCHE 氏

Helga Zepp LaRouche was born on August 25, 1948 in Trier, Germany. After high school, in 1968 she continued her education as a journalist in Hamburg and Hannover. When she had completed volunteer time with the Hannover press, she worked as a free-lance journalist. In 1971, she traveled for many months through China, as one of the first European journalists, at the highpoint of the Cultural Revolution. After her return, she began to study political science, history and philosophy at the Otto Suhr Institute of the Free University of Berlin. Later she continued her studies at the Frankfurt/Main University. On December 29, 1977, Helga Zepp and Lyndon H. LaRouche were married in Wiesbaden. Since then, together with her husband, she has pursued her political activities in many Asian nations, Europe, Latin America and practically all the states of the United States. She has met with numerous political leaders, including Indian Prime Minister Indira Gandhi and Mexican President Jose Lopez-Portillo. Helga Zepp-LaRouche is one of the world's leading authorities on Friedrich Schiller and on Nicolaus of Cusa, the man who contributed more than anyone else to the launching of the European Renaissance of the Fifteenth century. Her scientific work extends from the German Classical period, to the humanist tradition of universal history, and Confucianism.

## ■Paulo Nogueira BATISTA Junior 氏

The economist Paulo Nogueira Batista Júnior has been appointed as vice-president of the New Development Bank of the BRICS, which is being established in Shanghai (China). Batista Júnior is a professor and researcher at the Getúlio Vargas Foundation (FGV) since 1989, where he has headed the Center for Monetary Studies and International Economy. He has also been a visiting-professor at the Institute of Advanced Studies of the University of Sao Paulo (USP), from 1996 to 1998 and from 2002 to 2004. He has worked as special secretary of Economic Affairs of the Ministry of Planning, Budget and Management between 1985 and 1988, and as special advisor for External Debt of the Ministry of Finance, from 1986 to 1987.
