- But, No roadmap for Denuclearization

Trump-Kim Joint Statement, June 12

President Trump and Chairman Kim Jong Un conducted a comprehensive, in-depth, and sincere exchange of opinions on the issues related to the establishment of new U.S.–DPRK relations and the building of a lasting and robust peace regime on the Korean Peninsula.

President Trump committed to provide security guarantees to the DPRK, and Chairman Kim Jong Un reaffirmed his firm and unwavering commitment to complete denuclearization of the Korean Peninsula.

Trump-Kim Joint Statement, June 12

- Establish new U.S.–DPRK relations
- Join their efforts to build a lasting and stable peace regime
- Complete denuclearization of the Korean Peninsula
- Recovering POW/MIA remains

Panmunjom Declaration, April 27

- Improving Inter-Korean Relations
- Easing Military Tension
- Establishing Permanent Peace Regime

Chairman Kim's Conditions

- Nuclear Free “Korean Peninsula”
- Eliminating Military Threat on the KP
- Security guarantee for the regime
- Phased and Synchronized approach

Phased Approach to Denuclearization?

- start with measures that would be easiest for Pyongyang to accept and relatively easy to verify
- proceed to more comprehensive, strategically meaningful, and harder-to-verify measures
- continue by establishing a credible baseline for
- culminate in the phased removal and dismantlement of all nuclear weapons, fissile materials, and accountable missiles.

- Political aspect

New Order in Northeast Asia?

- Ending Korean War/ Peace Treaty → UNC
- Easing Military Tension → USFK
- OPCON Transfer → CFC, US-ROK alliance
