- » Mobile, digital devices and internet solutions


A HIGHER LEVEL OF PREVENTION: Do we have the skills to assess the technological opportunities that are specifically aimed at improving the working environment?





#### **Digitalisation – the journey towards a higher level of prevention**

Procurement of new occupational health and safety technology





- **Passive:** No focus on new SHW technology
- **Reactive:** We only focus on new SHW technology if problems arise such as accidents, stress, sick leave or collaboration challenges

- Active: We are considering new SHW technology, but more in words than in action
- **Proactive:** We investigate and implement new SHW technologies to improve the level of prevention
- **Creative:** We plan how we can introduce new SHW technology that optimizes both our business and our working environment.
