

Vision Zero for All was issued as the Tokyo Declaration



Declares that Vision Zero

1. Is a strategy and holistic mindset for prevention, which is built on the common desire to promote and establish a global prevention culture, and aims at reducing accidents and occupational diseases, and at promoting safety, health and well-being at work;
4. Contributes to the 2030 Sustainable Development Goals, in particular SDG 8 (Decent Work and Economic Growth), SDG 3 (Good Health and Wellbeing), SDG 4 (Quality Education) and SDG 17 (Partnerships for the Goals);






