#### 1. *Tokyo-Cambridge Gazette*: グローバル戦略編第51号

6月初旬にドイツで催された国際会議に出席したが、恥ずかしながら日本に居る時には筆者が普段注意を払わない視点を認識した。それは英国の中国専門家、ウィリアム・キャラハン教授が著書(*China: The Pessoptimist Nation*, Oxford University Press, 2010)の中で指摘された視点だ—「極東の現況・歴史に関し、国際的に共有される認識が日本の“外”で形成されつつある」、と。即ち、世界で活躍する中国人と付き合う欧米人は、歴史を含む日中関係を親しい中国人から直接聞いて、独自の対日イメージを抱き始めているのである。

次に、李克強首相訪独直後だったためか、対中外交に関するEUの中心が、「EU本部が在るブラッセルからドイツの首都ベルリンに移るかも知れない(“Berlin may be replacing Brussels in a German Europe”)」との見解が広まっていた—欧州危機以降、浸透しつつあるこの視点(“Just as China is a rising global power, so Germany is a rising power within Europe”)にご関心のある方は、例えば欧州外交評議会(EFCR)のハンス・クンナニ氏の論文(“China and Germany: Why the Emerging Special Relationship Matters for Europe,” May 2012)を参照されたい。

また中国・欧州間の価値観の同異に触れて、筆者は①“the Rule of Law”に関してはマックス・ヴェーバーの『儒教と道教(*Konfuzianismus und Taoismus*)』を、②コミュニケーションの大切さに関しては、ヘルマン・ヘッセの『ガラス玉遊戯(*Das Glasperlenspiel*)』を引用した。そうした理由は、発表時間が限られていたが故に、聴衆の教養に頼りつつ簡潔な発言を心掛けたからであった。嬉しいことに発表後、何人かのドイツの紳士から優しい言葉を頂いた—①「ヴェーバーの名前を見るまで、現代中国を研究するドイツ人が達した結論だと勘違いしておりました」、と。また②「あなたのお蔭で、美しいドイツ語の小説を思い出すことが出来ました」、と。かくして筆者は今、日中関係における“グローバリゼーションの深化”を実感している。

### 3. 編集後記

冒頭で触れた国際会議が終了した後、ベルリン自由大学の友人達と戦後における日独両国の「歴史問題」を語り合った。友人達は、同大学のゼバスチャアン・コンラート教授のご著書(*Auf der Suche nach der verlorenen Nation: Geschichtsschreibung in Westdeutschland und Japan 1945-1960*, Göttingen: Vandenhoeck & Ruprecht, 1998)に触れて、日本の歴史認識の特質—特に東洋史と西洋史が学術的・制度的に独立して存在し、包括的な世界史的視点に欠ける点—に関し冷静かつ穏やかな口調ではあるが厳しい批判を述べた。筆者は、日本の立場を弁護し、また反論すると同時に、彼等の意見に対して理解も示した次第である。そして敬愛する西田幾多郎先生が、愛弟子でカント哲学者、高坂正顕先生へのお手紙の中で語られた言葉を紹介した—「国史をやるには先ず西洋史をやる方がよい。今日<sup>わが</sup>国史がだめなのは<sup>ただ</sup>唯国史だけやるからだ」、と。因みに、コンラート教授のご著書は残念なことに邦訳が無く、米語訳のみが存在するだけだ(*The Quest for the Lost Nation: Writing History in Germany and Japan in the American Century*, Berkeley, CA: University of California Press, 2010)。かくして今、国際世論を味方にするために、「日本は努めて冷静かつ知的に對外発信をしなくては」と考えている。 以上
